

Juvenile Hall Auxiliary School Assistance Program

The Juvenile Hall Auxiliary offers financial aid to students who were or are in placement under the jurisdiction of the Court in the amounts of at least \$300.00 per quarter or \$500.00 per semester. The money is to be used for post high school education in the academic, vocational, or specialized training fields. We expect our students to commit themselves to a full-time educational program.

Eligibility

In order to qualify, the student must be a high school graduate with a reputation for dependability and have taken and provided to the Auxiliary a copy of their assessment tests, from their desired institution. Also, the applicant must set up an interview with our Career Assistance Counselor.

The applicant must send the completed application to the Juvenile Hall Auxiliary office, 202 Glacier Drive, Martinez, CA 94553

Payment

Payment will be made directly to the student.

Re-Application

To receive future funding, we ask that you submit a transcript or copy of your grades and documentation that you have enrolled for another quarter/semester. We also require that you receive at least a 2.0 GPA.

Any deviation from this representation to the board may be grounds for the cancellation of any grant of financial aid.

I acknowledge that the following criteria will be used to evaluate my proposal for grant aid: (1) my character, my ability, my motivation and potential exhibited by me to the board; (2) the likelihood that my proposal and my plan can be successfully achieved; (3) the financial need of me as applicant; and (4) the currently available resources of the Juvenile Hall Auxiliary's absolute discretion.
